### My role in the diocese and parish

Newer parishioners may not know that my full time ministry is (and will be continuing ) at the Institute for Mission (IFM) - our Diocese's centre for adult life and faith formation. I am the director of that place - a not for profit organisation tasked to develop programs, media and resources to serve the whole Diocese.

My coming to Emu Plains a year ago was based on two connected questions: 1. to see if I could adequately assist the parish needs here in addition to my IFM role – especially as it was possible Emu Plains might not have a priest otherwise and

2. to see if there was a possibility to expand the IFM work towards greater Penrith and the Mountains. The answers to both are still about 50/50 but here's to trying. I admit I struggled with 2019's pressures and I know that some parishioners have not been happy with things, preferring other ways and arrangements. At the same time I'm thankful for the understanding of many, (including some who'd prefer another priest without a role in the Diocese). As the year unfolds and I continue to discern what's possible ahead, I'll certainly hold in prayer the hopes, goals and challenges of many in the parish also embracing next steps of life and faith in 2020.
