EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:

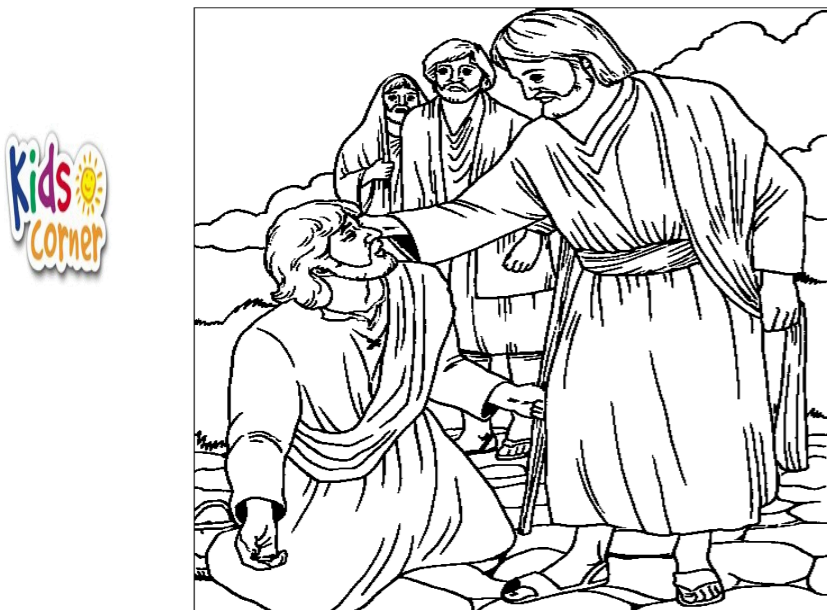
Will be an ongoing devotion for our Parish each Friday after the 9.00am
